Classroom Activities

Our last butterfly came out over the weekend. We released it on Monday. In math we are still working on writing the numbers 0-10. Many students know the numbers 0-10 when shown them but writing them can often be more difficult. We will begin subitizing next week. Subitizing is when you look at the 3 dots on a die and know automatically that it represents 3. while writing the numbers.

In writing we are working on representing at least the first sound of words. To help your child with this, give him/her a word and ask for the first sound in the word and then

the letter that makes that sound. This can be done in the car while driving or even when eating together. Some students are writing beginning and ending sounds while others are writing the entire word. Another way to motivate your child to write is to have them write letters to family or even a grocery list. In social studies, we will finish our unit on families. We have also talked about other groups we belong to. We are all members of our class and teams your child belongs to. Next week we will begin our science unit of force and motion.
