Unit 1 Geometry: 2D shapes

During this unit, we will cover names of 2D shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon) regardless of orientation or size. (I.E. a square is still a square even when turned to the side like a diamond) We will also be putting shapes together, like a puzzle, to make larger shapes. This is the first step to working with fractions as we will be discussing equal parts, halves, etc. We will be locating shapes in our environment as well as drawing the shapes. **We sent you our chapter vocabulary to work on this week. ☺**

Patterning and sorting will also be introduced during this unit.

Suggested activities to do at home:

1. Go on a shape hunt in your house and have your child find a specific shape. (I.E. Find things shaped like a circle. A saucer, a plate, a CD, etc.)
2. Have your child make a picture using shapes and have the child name the shapes used.
3. Cut shapes out of paper and have your child create new shapes by putting the cutouts together. 
4. Use Fruit loops cereal and have your child make patterns.
5. **Play shape game in homework bag.**
